





Sopot is undoubtedly the most beautiful resort in Poland today. Already in the 19th century, patients who wanted to improve their health thanks to healing baths were coming to Sopot.

The status of the international resort of Sopot gained in the interwar period. The treatments for the Polish sea were coming from all over Europe and the visit in Sopot was not only beneficial for health, but also in many circles obligatory for social reasons.

Currently, there are over a dozen **high-class SPA centers** operating in Sopot. The range of services offered by them can surprise with wealth and diversity. Both enthusiasts of exotic massages and more traditional treatments will find something for themselves. What undoubtedly connects Sopot spa and wellness centers is to base a significant part of the offer on the richness of the sea. Salts, amber and sea algae are an irreplaceable basis for many unique treatments.







Sopot Brine Oo

The spa waters, or brine, from the St. Wojciech spring flow spontaneously from a depth of 800m. It is a 4.3% bromide-iodine brine, containing large amounts of potassium, magnesium, and iodine.

The brine contains the same percentage of salt as the Red Sea. In its natural concentration of 4.3% it can only be used for **external purposes** such as **inhalation** or **bathing**.

The brine is only suitable for drinking in a diluted form and you can try it in the **Brine Water Pump Room** located on the top floor of the Spa House (entrance is via the panoramic elevator). Diluted brine can be used to supplement mineral salt deficiencies.





Sopot is constantly expanding its cultural offer and its achievements in the promotion of culture and art have been recognised with numerous awards and top rankings.

Proportionately, Sopot has one of the highest cultural and art offerings for its residents in the country and the team of the Res Publica Foundation has recognised Sopot as a city in which creators of culture have the best conditions for development.

There is a strong calendar of cyclical events such as the Mundus Cantat International Choir Festival, the Literary Sopot Festival, as well as the Sopot Jazz Festival.

Aside from the cultural offer in Sopot there are also the Forest Opera, the State Art Gallery, Sopot Museum as well as three theatre stages.







Sport 4

In Sopot you can enjoy almost all types of sport, from sailing and windsurfing through to horse riding and from Nordic walking to winter sports.

The sports and recreation options are supplemented with the largest indoor and outdoor **tennis** court complex in Poland.

The real pride of Sopot is the **40-hectare hippodrome**. This horse racing track host many international competitions every year, among which **CSIO 5*** (Concours de Saut International Officiel) can be mentioned.



Accommodation

The accommodation base in Sopot is very varied. There are 21 classified hotels in the city, which together can offer over 3 300 beds.

This group includes both hotels of **global** chains (Radisson Blu, Sheraton, Sofitel Grand, Marriott Resort & Spa) as well as **boutique** and spa hotels (Hotel Haffner, Hotel Sopot, Sopotorium Medical Resort, Hotel Testa, Hotel Sopot, Hotel Rezydent).

Some of them have **conference centers** that can accommodate events from several dozen to even 1 500 people.

In addition, over 11000 beds are offered by non-classified facilities (apartments, private accommodation, camping sites).
